

Americanism Committee:

Americanism Committee: Bruce Maney reported as of today's August 8, 2019 Chapter meeting, the Button Gwinnett Chapter has participated in events to earn 4695 Americanism points and 2170 President General's Streamer points. Americanism points are earned in the following categories: Publicity from Print & Media; Publicity through Broadcast Media; SAR Speaker Bureau; Youth Programs; Public Service Programs, Veterans Support; Special Observances and Ceremonies; and, SAR Medals and Certificates Awarded to Non-SAR members.

Color Guard:

Color Guard Commander Bill Palmer was not present. In his absence, at his request, Eldon Evans announced that the Button Gwinnett Chapter, Col. John Collins Chapter and Piedmont Chapter will conduct a ceremony honoring three Patriots buried at the Marietta National Cemetery. Each of the three Chapters will represent one of the graves. Our Button Gwinnett Chapter will honor Patriot George Bradford, Piedmont Chapter will honor Patriot John Clark and Col. John Collins Chapter will honor Patriot John Haynes. The ceremony is tentatively scheduled for Saturday April 4, 2020. During the ceremony, the GSSAR Elijah Clark Militia will mourn muskets but firing is not allowed in the cemetery. Bill will need some volunteers from the Chapter to: (1) read the bio, (2) uncover the headstone, (3) give the invocation and benediction and (4) play the bugle.
